Expect Respect BP-PBIS Campaign (4th - 12th grade)

BP-PBIS is a universal intervention designed to be implemented school-wide. It gives students the tools to reduce bullying behavior through the blending of positive behavior support, simple responses to disrespectful behavior, and a functional approach to the bullying construct.

TIPS team training includes an opportunity to: Build team fluency for effective and efficient problem solving following a six-step process Complete a progress monitoring tool for planning, implementing and sustaining best practice meeting foundations and data based problem solving
