PBIS Tier I Leadership Academy is designed as an advanced and interactive training aligned with the National Technical Assistance Center on Positive Behavioral Interventions and Support *Training and Professional Development Blueprint (2016)*. This academy provides the necessary content and key professional development skill sets to build internal systems capacity for sustained implementation of Tier I systems, practices and data.

Outcomes

Understand the essential features of a Tier I PBIS **Professional Development System**

Delve deeper in the science and logic for **systems change work, applied behavioral analysis, prevention** and **implementation**

Develop Tier I key content knowledge and skills to support the implementation stages of PBIS **systems, practices** and **data**

Explore training and support curriculum aligned with the **Tier I Tiered Fidelity Inventory (TFI)** and **Eight Steps of Implementation**

Practice and refine **facilitation, training** and **coaching skill sets** to support PBIS sustainability

Design a professional development **evaluation plan** to:

- 1) assess school team mastery and implementation
- 2) assess trainer and/or coach current levels of knowledge and skills; and
- 3) monitor student outcomes

PBIS Coordinators and External Coaches who:

1. support existing PBIS school site teams
2. co-train with statewide CalTAC-PBIS or regional PBIS trainers
3. have an existing PBIS Action Plan linked to a District Improvement Plan
