### Module 1 – Foundations for Supporting Student Social-Emotional-Behavioral (SEB) Wellbeing

**Date: August 24, 2023**

### Module 2 – Student-Driven Check-in/Check-out (CICO) for High School

**Date: September 7, 2023**

Develop and implement systems to maximize student ownership and engagement in Check-In/Check-Out. Explore the adaptations to procedural components of CICO necessary for student participation and fit within the organizational structures and content of high schools.

### Module 3 – Check and Reflect

**Date: September 21, 2023**

Co-design simple SEB support plans with CICO components, functional behavioral assessments, student-driven interviews, Social and Emotional Learning and Pillars of Healthy Minds strategies to address common mental health concerns.

### Module 4 – Prevent Teach Reinforce (PTR)\* Secondary

**Date: October 5, 2023**

Co-create a standardized, team-based, comprehensive SEB support plan promoting self-determination.

The *Prevent-Teach-Reinforce Secondary* is an adaptation of PTR\* with emphasis on student involvement. Adaptations include student version documents for goal setting, assessment, intervention checklists and self-monitoring tools.

### Module 5 – Student-Centered Planning Process

**Date: January 17, 2024**

Develop and implement a planning process with students using strength-based tools based upon a set of shared values promoting relatedness (purpose and sense of belonging), competence (mastery) and autonomy (self-regulation).
